

AWARENESS ALERT! ACUTE AORTIC SYNDROME (AAS)

- What is Acute Aortic Syndrome (AAS)? Chest pain as a result of a distended thoracic aorta.
- Who has AAS? Patients with thoracic aneurysms or dissections combined with hypertension.
- Why is AAS a critical condition? Without appropriate diagnosis and treatment, aortic rupture or dissection often lead to loss of life.
- How is AAS diagnosed? With contrast enhanced spiral CT or transesophageal echocardiogram. EKG and cardiac enzymes will be grossly normal.
- Where should a patient with AAS receive treatment? Preferably, a center with thoracic aortic surgery capabilities. If not available, a medical center with open heart surgery capabilities.
